## WHITE PLAINS OUTDOOR ARTS FESTIVAL 56th ANNUAL SHOW June 2 and 3, 2018

### \$10,500 in Scholarships Awarded

**White Plains, NY – May 29, 2018.** The 56<sup>th</sup> Annual White Plains Outdoor Arts Festival (“WPOAF”) will take place on Saturday, June 2 and Sunday, June 3, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily in Tibbits Park, at North Broadway and Main Street in White Plains. This treasured community attraction is a free event that is enjoyed by thousands of Westchester residents of all ages.

In the tree lined park, a sea of white tents will rise early Saturday morning. Artists from far and wide will set up their works and visitors will shop for beautiful art work for their homes, find perfect pieces of jewelry to accompany summer fashions, and purchase unique, one-of-a-kind gifts for friends and family. The festival will feature approximately 55 artists displaying paintings, photography, ceramics, leather work, textiles, jewelry and many other handcrafted items. The attractions will also include children's art activities, an exhibit of the scholarship winners' work, and an emerging artists' display. In addition, guests of the show will enjoy the very popular raffle tent, with items donated by many of our participating artists, as well as a food court where visitors can dine al fresco.

The all-volunteer organizing committee of the WPOAF is committed to producing a top-notch cultural event for the City of White Plains every year, however that is not their only mission. The committee also dedicates all proceeds from the show and devotes additional fundraising efforts to its Scholarship Fund for White Plains High School seniors who plan to study fine arts in college.

This year, WPOAF awarded \$10,500 in art scholarships to 5 White Plains High School Seniors who demonstrated exceptional talent and devotion to their art. Scholarships were awarded to Lauren Reid, Jackii Torres, Kelly Marx, Lindsay Smith, and Allie Lambert. The committee estimates that in the over 40 years that it has sponsored scholarships, it has awarded in excess of \$195,000.
