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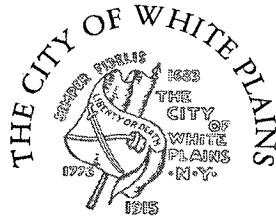
**TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL:**

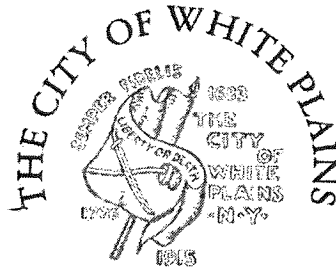

The Capital Projects Board has recommended a project entitled "Kittrell Park Basketball Courts" in the Capital Improvement Program for fiscal year 2022-23. This project includes installing a new surface, levelling and relining of basketball courts and the replacement of basketball stanchions and backboards with baskets.

Submitted herein is legislation which would authorize the Mayor to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to enter into various contracts, as necessary, to complete the project.

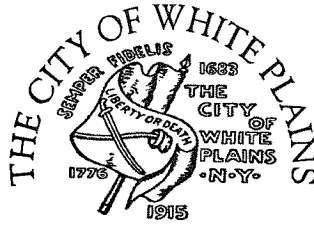

Submitted herewith is an ordinance amending the Traffic Ordinance of the City of White Plains as follows:

- 1.) Modify "Speed of Motor Vehicles, Etc" as described in Section 302, Subdivisions 1, 3(b), 3(g), 3(i), 3(j), 3(k), 3(l), 3(m), 3(n), 3(o), 3(p), 3(q), 3(r), 3(s), 3(t), 3(u), 3(v), 3(w), 3(x), 3(y), 3(z), 3(aa), 3(ab) and 3(ac).

This amendment is in accordance with the New York State Legislation (A.1007-A/S.2021-A) which allows cities to reduce city wide limits to 25 miles per hour as described in the amended Section 1643 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law. Research shows that faster driving speeds correlate to more serious injuries and fatalities for pedestrians in the event of a crash. Under the old law the default maximum speed limit throughout a city, town, or village could not be set to lower than 30 miles per hour. By giving municipalities local control to reduce speed limits, this new legislation will improve public safety and prevent pedestrian fatalities. This amendment is in accordance with recommendations of the Transportation Commission and is to become effective upon adoption by the Common Council.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE PLAINS TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF WHITE PLAINS FROM 30 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES PER HOUR EXCEPT FOR THE ROADS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED IN SECTION 302(3)**

The Common Council of the City of White Plains hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

**SECTION 302. SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES, ETC.**

**Section 1.** Article III, Section 302 of an ordinance adopted by the Common Council of the City of White Plains on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September 1946, entitled, “An Ordinance of the City of White Plains regulating traffic in the City of White Plains and providing penalties for the violations of its provisions,” as last amended on the 1<sup>ST</sup> day of February 2021, is hereby amended to read as following

1. No motor vehicle, motorcycle or other vehicle of any description whatever shall be run, driven or operated upon any street or public highway within the corporate limits of the City of White Plains at a rate of speed greater than ~~thirty-two-and-a-half~~ thirty-two-and-a-half miles per hour, nor at the places and at the times now or hereafter set forth in subdivision 2 of section fifty six of the vehicle and traffic law at a greater rate of speed than the maximum limits now or hereafter specified therein as to such respective places.

3. (b) Mamaroneck Avenue from Bryant Avenue to the city line, forty miles per hour, except during periods of school days when the speed limit shall be twenty-five miles per hour in areas marked by yellow flashing lights signals and signs reading twenty-five miles per hour. From Bryant Avenue to Main Street, thirty miles per hour.

(g) Bryant Avenue between North Street and Westchester Avenue both eastbound and westbound ~~thirty-five~~ thirty-five miles per hour. From North Street to South Lexington Avenue, thirty miles per hour.

(i) Bank Street, thirty miles per hour.

(j) Battle Avenue, thirty miles per hour.

(k) Bloomngdale Road, thirty miles per hour

(l) Central Avenue, thirty miles per hour

(m) Chatterton Avenue, thirty miles per hour

(n) Chatterton Parkway, thirty miles per hour

- (o) East Post Road, thirty miles per hour
- (p) Fisher Avenue, thirty miles per hour
- (q) Hamilton Avenue, thirty miles per hour
- (r) Main Street, thirty miles per hour
- (s) Martin Luther King Jr Boulevard, thirty miles per hour
- (t) Maple Avenue, thirty miles per hour
- (u) North Broadway, thirty miles per hour
- (v) Old Mamaroneck Road, thirty miles per hour
- (w) Ridgeway, thirty miles per hour
- (x) Rosedale Avenue, thirty miles per hour
- (y) Soundview Avenue, thirty miles per hour
- (z) South Broadway, thirty miles per hour
- (aa) South Lexington Avenue, thirty miles per hour
- (ab) Tarrytown Road, thirty miles per hour
- (ac) West Post Road, thirty miles per hour

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately
