
Mr. Livingston - My name is Veda Tyson and I reside at 23 Meadowbrook Rd in White Plains. Over the past 4 years, I have sent emails to Westchester County, the WPCSD and White Plains public officials. I have continually expressed concern about the lack of sidewalks on North Street between 333 Westchester Avenue and WPHS.

I have two children that attend WPHS and one child that attends Highlands MS. There are no sidewalks or crosswalks connecting my neighborhood with White Plains. When my children walk to school, they have to walk on the grass and cross the streets without any walk signs. Due to the snow, my children must walk on the street.

This is one of those issues that is a matter of time before someone is hurt, and it is avoidable. Please let me know if there is anything that can be done about this before someone is hurt.


