FOR
OWNER OCCUPIED COOPERATIVE UNITS**

The City of White Plains, in partnership with the New York State Home & Community Renewal Affordable Housing Corporation, has received funding for a **NEW** White Plains Home Improvement Program. The White Plains AHC Home Improvement Program provides financial assistance to owner-occupied cooperative units for needed home repairs.

Acceptable repairs include:

- Emergency kitchen repairs
- Bathroom leaks, plumbing, broken walls and tiles
- Emergency electrical repairs

Requirements:

- Property must be an owner occupied cooperative unit
- Household eligibility is qualified per yearly income total and family size based on HUD low-income limits
- Assets must not be greater than \$15,000
- All property taxes must be current
- Proof of current home insurance

To Apply:

- Contact the White Plains Community Development Department for program information and to request an application packet, 914-422-1300
- Applicants must set-up an appointment with Home Improvement Staff to review the completed application and required qualifying documentation
