

DPW Permit Restrictions
During the Holiday Shopping Season
November 1st – New Year's Day

HOLIDAY MORATORIUM

Effective November 1st through the first business day of the New Year, there will be no DPW permits issued for the following: street openings; street obstructions; maintenance operations.

Except in cases of emergency, or as may be otherwise authorized in writing by the Commissioner of Public Works; no permits shall be issued for work within the public right-of-ways. Affected areas include those in, or contiguous to, the downtown Central Business areas, as well as streets designated as County Roads, within the City of White Plains. The Westchester County roadway list can be found on the City's website: www.cityofwhiteplains.com, under the Public Works, Highway Section. In the event that such emergency work is authorized by the Commissioner of Public Works working hours will continue to be restricted and will be strictly enforced.

RESTORATION

In accordance with city ordinances, openings must be backfilled and satisfactorily resurfaced and any obstructions must be removed on Saturday, Sunday or holidays – or at the expiration of the effective period of the permit, as provided above. The City of White Plains reserves the right to backfill and resurface such openings or to remove such obstructions by contract or otherwise, at the permittee's own expense.

TRAFFIC PLATES

The use of steel traffic plates will be in accordance with Chapter 7-3 of the **White Plains Municipal Code** as amended. In addition to other requirements, the Code requires a sign located two hundred feet before the plate reading "Plate Ahead" and a sign five feet before the plate reading "Raise Plow." A daily fee of \$50 for each traffic lane affected, plus an additional \$10 for each plate used, will be charged during the time period as specified in the Code. Plates shall be recessed, where determined by the Commissioner. Plates shall be used for the minimum possible time and only when specifically requested by the applicant at the time of permits issuance, or as directed at any time by the Commissioner of Public Works.

Restrictions will be strictly enforced by the Department of Public Works Code Enforcement, and by the Commissioner of Public Works.
