**Subject: Contract No. 903162, Miscellaneous Street Reconstruction Oxford Road (Gedney Esp. to Heatherbloom Rd.)**

Dear Owner or Resident:

The Department of Public Works (DPW) has awarded a contract to Montesano Bros., Inc. for the above-captioned work. The reconstruction work will include stormwater drainage improvements, granite curbing, full-depth pavement replacement and other miscellaneous work.

We anticipate the work to commence on or about Wednesday, July 10, 2019 (weather permitting) and continue into late September, excluding holidays, when the major portion of the work will be completed. Should inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances prevent the Contractor from continuing as scheduled, the job may be temporarily suspended until such time that the weather improves and the work under this Contract can recommence.

The street will be closed to general vehicular traffic during the project. Access for residents, emergency vehicles, deliveries, and sanitation & recycling collection will always be provided. Working hours will be approximately 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Please note that garbage or recycling collection may be made as early as 7:00 A.M. or after 3:30 P.M. during the construction period. Street parking must also be temporarily suspended within the construction area and appropriate signing will be provided as necessary.

Some of the work may interfere with plantings or private sprinkler systems located within the City's right-of-way (ROW) property. Every effort to prevent their disturbance will be made, however the City is not responsible for private sprinkles systems or plantings within the municipal ROW.

While the contract progresses, your patience and cooperation are essential and will be most appreciated as we look to the completion of this project. City DPW personnel will be on site at all times to insure the satisfactory performance of the Contract.
