The White Plains My Brother's Keeper will celebrate its 3rd Anniversary, Thursday, December 19, 2019 6 p.m. at the Thomas Slater Center, 2 Fisher Court, White Plains, NY. The White Plains My Brother's Keeper was established in White Plains by Mayor Thomas Roach and Superintendent of School Dr. Joseph Ricca to address the opportunity gap for boys and young men of color.
