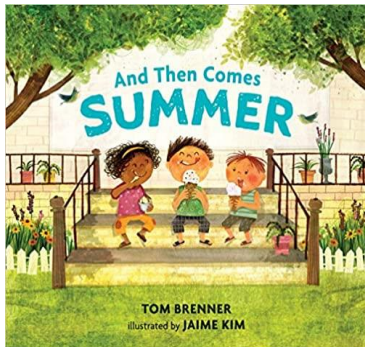

PARK *STORY WALK***
