*At no time shall the total cost of a Special Permit Application fee and Inspection fee exceed 50% of the cost of the storm water construction costs. The cost of construction will be determined by the Commissioner of Public Works after reviewing information submitted by the permittee. All determinations by the Commissioner will be final.

NOTE: All plans, drawings or other materials submitted to the Department of Public Works (DPW) shall become the property of DPW and part of the permanent record of any approval.

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Requirements:

1. All work, (i.e. erosion and sediment control, sediment management, subsurface connections, etc.) will be performed in accordance with all specifications and requirements of DPW, and all necessary permits will be secured before any work is started.
2. If the drain system is not accepted as a municipal public improvement by the Stormwater Management Officer (SMO), the drain system and connection shall remain private and shall be maintained by the property owner(s).
3. All conditions affecting the City's MS-4 shall be subject to the approval and inspection by the SMO. The applicant must notify DPW at least two (2) business days prior to commencing work and at least two (2) business days prior to final restoration.
4. Any connection shall not be removed without the written consent of the SMO.
5. If it is determined by the SMO that this connection is a detriment to the municipal storm sewer system, this connection may be removed without notice to the property owner(s).

Indemnification:

The applicant/property owner shall indemnify and save the City harmless from any loss, damage or expense, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs, claims or suits arising out of and in connection with the installation and connection to the City's MS4. In addition, the SMO makes no guarantee that its MS4 will not become surcharged or otherwise overburdened and that water from the MS4 will not back-up through the connection onto the owner's property. By making a connection, the applicant/owner assumes all of the risk and liability that may arise from it.

This authorization and agreement is binding on the present owner(s) of record, all heirs, assigns and successors.

NOTE: By affixing signatures to this form, the Applicant/Owner(s) of Record hereby verify that they have reviewed the specific requirements relative to this application for connection to public storm sewer system construction permit; and they take full responsibility for this application.
