THE CITY OF WHITE PLAINS COMMISSIONER OF PARKING

Salary: \$179,300

Under the general direction of the Mayor, the incumbent directs and manages the Parking Department and is responsible for all policies, planning, development, budgeting, cost containment, marketing, programs, facility operations, maintenance, capital improvements, safety, security and activities. Also responsible for the enforcement of parking and quality of life rules, regulations and ordinances, including the authorization to enforcement staff for the issuance of tickets and appearance summonses. Directs the regulation of the City's traffic; traffic control devices; and traffic requirements; and serves as a Member of the Traffic Commission. Under the provisions of the WP City Charter, this is an appointed position, vested with the authority to appoint, supervise and remove staff; and to appoint Deputies. The Commissioner of Parking appoints, directs and has authority to discharge department staff. Directs and controls the activities, operations, strategic planning and special programs of the Parking Department; does related work as required.

DESIRABLE TRAINING AND QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's Degree* in engineering, architecture, finance, management, business administration or a related field and six (6) years experience in parking or facilities operations or a related field, four (4) years of which must have been at a responsible administrative or management level involving staff supervision. A Master's Degree* may substitute for one year of the above experience.

***NOTE:** Education beyond the secondary level must be from a regionally accredited institution or one recognized or accredited by the Board of Regents of the New York State Department of Education as a post-secondary degree granting institution.
