

WINTER SAFETY TIPS



Do's & Don'ts to Help You & Your Family Stay Safe this Winter.

Planning ahead for a storm can make things easier for you and your family. Below is a list of resources to help you and your family enjoy a safe winter season.

Do subscribe to the [City of White Plains CodeRed Emergency Notification Alerts System](#) to receive real-time emergency notifications directly to your phone.

Do refer to the City of [White Plains Department of Public Safety website for Winter Storm Guidance](#) on how to stay safe before, during and after snow events.

Don't park cars on the street when it snows or when snow is in the forecast. Day or night, snow plows must be able to clear the streets of snow safely and effectively. Cars that remain on the street may get plowed in and are susceptible to receiving a parking summons. The Department of Public Works provides information on [Snow Removal Guidelines](#).

Don't let children and/or pets play in or near the street when plows are in operation.

Don't go near downed power lines.

Do call 911 to report a downed powerline.

Do contact Con Edison at 1.800.75 CONED to report downed wires.

Do call the White Plains Forestry Department at 914.422.1202 to report downed trees or tree limbs.
