The individual selected will serve as the Grand Marshal for the City of White Plains 2023 Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony. The event will be held on Monday, May 29, 2023 at 10 am.

Selection criteria:

- Must be available to attend the Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony
- Must currently reside in White Plains
- Must be a U.S. veteran or currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces
- U.S. veteran must have received an honorable discharge

All nominations will be evaluated by the Mayor’s Memorial and Veterans Day Board.
