### Firewood Warning!

New York's urban and rural forests are under attack from numerous invasive insect pests that are infesting and killing thousands of trees.

To help prevent the spread of deadly invasive pests, which have killed more than 50 million trees in neighboring states:

- It is illegal to bring untreated firewood into New York State.
- It is illegal to transport untreated firewood more than 50 miles from its source.

Be sure to obtain an origination certificate whenever you get firewood. Call 866-640-0652 for more information.
